

## TO RETIRE WITH HEALTH BENEFITS

Age	Years of Service	Coverage (WC I) (Must retire from active service)
62.5–64*	25	Full (active) benefits
65+	10	<p><b>Retirees in NYC, Nassau, Suffolk, Westchester and FL**:</b> Mandatory Medicare Advantage Plan (currently Aetna in NY)</p> <p><b>Other Retirees:</b> Enhanced Medicare benefit including: premium reimbursement (50%); Part A first-day deductible, co-insurance and reserve days; full Rx; life insurance; burial</p>
55–64	10	<p><b>Dental Plus Plan:</b> Dental; vision; limited hospital indemnity; spouse coverage***</p> <p>OR</p> <p><b>Prescription Plan:</b> Vision/Hearing; Rx; spouse coverage***</p>

\* Members born before July 1, 1959, are eligible for retiree health benefits at age 62 with 20 years of service.

\*\* Florida retirees may have a modest co-pay for office visits and are not eligible for dental benefits.

\*\*\* Eligible members retiring at age 60–64 are eligible for the “65+” benefits when they turn 65 and enroll in Medicare.
