Permanent Home Care Options

1. Department for the Aging Expanded In-home Services for Elderly Persons (EISEP)

- Subsidized home care based on income and household expenses
- Either Housekeeping or Personal Care services
- Offers no more than 4 hours a day, 5 days a week of service
- Only available within NYC and offered by different community agencies throughout each borough

2. Medicaid Managed Long Term Care

- Must be enrolled in Medicaid and qualify for long term care services
- Medicaid Income limits and savings/asset limits apply
- Amount of home care hours given are determined by the Managed Long-Term Care plan and are based on the individual's care needs

3. Private-pay home care

- Can range from \$15-\$30/hour, depending on the home care agency that is hired
- Individual creates their own schedule and selects the home care hours needed for their care

Temporary Home Care

1. Certified Home Health Aid Care (CHHA)

- o Paid by most employer/private insurances, Medicare and Medicaid
- A medical referral is required and approval is based on medical skilled service need not the home care need
- Must receive a medical skilled service in the home in order for the insurance to approve the home care portion of the service
- Limited to about 2-4 weeks of service, if additional care is needed another referral must be submitted and approval is subject to the insurance
